Winter Construction to Begin Three New Hotel Projects

CROWNE PLAZA GREENVILLE | GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA

Design will commence immediately with construction scheduled to start in early fall 2012. This will be the second renovation of this hotel by Winter Construction, the previous being completed in 1998.
