Winter Construction selected to lead construction of two Forsyth County recreation centers

The 42,000 square foot facilities are scheduled to open in early 2012

ATLANTA (March 14, 2011) – Winter Construction was selected by Forsyth County to build two recreation centers, one located in Fowler Park (near Highway 9 and Castleberry Road) and the other in the future Buice Recreation Center (at the intersection of Nichols and Old Atlanta roads). The recreation centers, which will each be 42,000 square feet upon completion, are scheduled to open in early 2012. Total project build out is expected to cost \$9.9 million.

Each recreation center will have two gymnasiums, a walking track, exercise rooms and administration offices. The centers will be constructed of masonry and structural steel.
